CO₂ emissions are measured separately from fuel consumption. Figures relate to standard-specification vehicles, and may vary significantly where optional equipment (including wider tyres) is fitted. Figures for fuel consumption and CO₂ emissions may vary depending on the wheels and tyres fitted.

⁴ Assuming car is fuelled to 90% of usable tank capacity, and allowing 68 kg for the driver and 7 kg for luggage. Figure quoted is for standard-specification vehicles. Optional equipment will increase this value.
